The Week 4 of the Faculty Development Course focused on : Creation of video resources using a methodology known as screen casting or screen recording

My reflections:

For the creation of video resources, I used Screencast-o-Matic open source software. Initially, I spent so much time in exploring the CamStudio software which unfortunately I could not use it for recording. I downloaded the software but it didn't open. It should error messages and didn't run in my computer. The spoken tutorial on CamStudio was very properly explained and presented.

The Screencast-o-matic software however was easier to use to record the narration and the video. I created my spoken tutorial on 'How to create website using Wordpress' in my mother language Assamesse (Duration:15 mins). I think it to be an interesting assignment because it made us make tutorials for local readers/viewers. Generally, the tutorials are made in English or Hindi at times. But this has led opportunity to explore better way to communicate with varied groups of people in India and abroad. This is for the first time I made a spoken tutorial and understood how audiovideos are created for audience. What are the points one should remember while writing a script which plays a major role in shaping up the tutorial.

During the interactions, many participants put their problems and share their knowledge which itself a remarkable opportunity for me to listen to others. During my Week 4, learning I learnt how to create spoken Tutorial with the Help of Screencast-omatic. I have uploaded my 15 minute audio-video on website creation using WordPress on YouTube and put it under Creative Commons license and shared the link in online discussion forums. Though a few peers have like the content but I feel the audio-quality could have been better. Due to lack of knowledge and proper equipment, I could not do proper sound. But I will try to improve it on my second screen casting for Moodle page.

My Reflections on:
